










THEMATIC MAPS OF DOHAR UPAZILA

Existing Landuse Map- Dohar Upazila




















Road Width Map-Dohar Upazila




Population Density Map-Dohar Upazila





















Proposed Drainage Network Map-Dohar Upazila













Horizontal X-section of Amphitheatre at Ward No. 4, Joypara Mouza -Dohar Upazila




Vertical X-section of Amphitheatre at Ward No. 4, Joypara Mouza -Dohar Upazila


